

Now Available: Updated COVID-19 Booster

The FDA has authorized the updated booster for Moderna for adults 18 years and older and for Pfizer for those 12 years and older. Everyone ages 12+ who has had their primary series should get the updated booster at least 2 months following any COVID vaccine or booster dose. SF Gov Website/Info is HERE.

The updated boosters are available for everyone aged 12+:

- Following completion of their primary series, regardless of vaccine product used
- Regardless of the number of booster doses received
- And are the only mRNA booster doses that are available to those 12 years and older. Those 12+ are no longer eligible for the current mRNA boosters based only on the original strain of the virus.

The FDA authorized the updated booster after reviewing data showing the booster improved protection against currently circulating variants. The updated booster increases immunity against the newer Omicron variants, which account for most current cases, as well as prior strains. As Omicron variants keep emerging, the updated booster dose is an important tool to protect us as it includes the dominant strains now.

SFUSD COVID-19 and Illness Protocol

What to do if your student does not feel well?

If your student is exhibiting any of the symptoms below, please have your student stay home. In order to return to school, your student will need a negative test result for Covid-19. Both PCR/NAAT/molecular and antigen tests are acceptable for testing for Covid-19.

Fever greater than 100.4° F, chills, cough	Sore throat	Shortness of breath	Headache	New loss of smell or taste
Nausea/vomiting	Diarrhea	Body aches	Fatigue	

What to do if your student tests positive for Covid-19?

SFUSD continues to work with the SF Department of Public Health to implement health and safety protocols to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 in schools. Based on <u>updated public health guidance</u> on December 31, 2021:

Students and staff who have tested positive for COVID-19 can return after 5 days of isolation if:

- They no longer have a fever, AND
- Their symptoms are getting better, AND
- They have a negative test collected on or after day 5.

Both PCR/NAAT/molecular and antigen tests are acceptable.

COLOR Testing Extended through December, 2022

COLOR self swab test kits will continue to be available through Dec 16th (at school sites) and Dec 21st (at central offices). These are not rapid test kits, but RT-LAMP testing that requires submitting a swab sample to be tested in a clinical lab. Test kits are available at school sites (drop off before 10 am) and central office locations (drop off before 4:30 pm). Pick up times vary so be sure to check the sticker on the bin to see if samples have been picked up for the day. Testing is not mandatory.
