SSC / ELAC Nomination

Dear Parents/Caregivers:

A.P. Giannini is holding elections for school committees, which must be completed by September 8, 2022. We invite you to [nominate yourself or others](#) for the following:

- **School Site Council (SSC)**
- **English Learners Advisory Committee (ELAC)**

A **School Site Council (SSC)** must be established at **all** San Francisco Unified School District public schools. The elected members represent parents, students, community members, and school staff in school governance. The SSC is responsible for the development of the Academic Plan, and overall school site budget including any categorical funds. The SSC is expected to:

- Review the SFUSD Strategic Plan: *Beyond the Talk*.
- Review and analyze student data.
- Solicit community input and develop a needs assessment.
- Assist the principal in developing the BSC/SPSA and school site budget.
- Monitor the implementation and effectiveness of the BSC/SPSA on an ongoing basis.
- Approve the Academic Plan and school site budget before it is submitted to the District for final review and approval.

The purpose of the **English Learners Advisory Committee (ELAC)** is to advise the principal, SSC and school staff on programs and services for *English Learners*. The tasks are similar to the SSC's (stated above) and also include: the annual language census and ways to make parents aware of the importance of regular school attendance.

The school council and committees are needed to support all school programs. **You are [invited to become a candidate for membership on the council and/or any or all of the committees of your choice](#). The school & district are responsible for providing you with the information and training you need to be an effective member.** Generally, the groups meet once a month for two hours. Each member is elected for either a one or two year term. Family members often offer insights on how effective our school is in creating a positive learning environment and how well their children understand their assignments. Perspectives, and parent participation/involvement are important to our school.

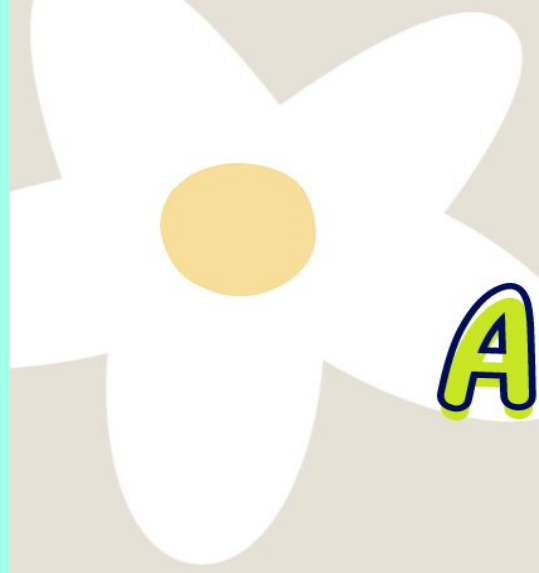

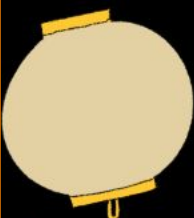
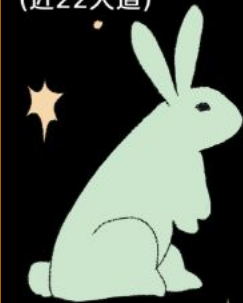

SFUSD Covid-19 Protocol

What to do if your student does not feel well?

If your student is exhibiting any of the symptoms below, please have your student stay home. In order to return to school, your student will need a negative test result for Covid. Both PCR/NAAT/molecular and antigen tests are acceptable for testing for Covid-19.

Fever greater than 100.4° F, chills, cough	Sore throat	Shortness of breath	Headache	New loss of smell or taste
Nausea/vomiting	Diarrhea	Body aches	Fatigue	

What to do if your student tests positive for Covid?

SFUSD continues to work with the SF Department of Public Health to implement health and safety protocols to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 in schools. Based on [updated public health guidance](#) on December 31, 2021:

Students and staff who have tested positive for COVID-19 can return after 5 days of isolation if:

- They no longer have a fever, AND
- Their symptoms are getting better, AND
- They have a negative test collected on or after day 5.

Both PCR/NAAT/molecular and antigen tests are acceptable.

To report a positive case:

- If unable to perform the above, please contact the school directly.
