TRANSITION TO MIDDLE SCHOOL - QUICK TIPS!

- ★ Can't find your class? Feeling lost? Looking for the bathroom? Have a question? Please don't be afraid to ask! Our school staff and peers are here to help support your transition to middle school! :)
- ★ Write down homework and assignments for each of your classes. Check your Google Classroom and school email on a regular basis to make sure you're caught up.
- ★ Get enough sleep every night and eat breakfast, so you can be energized, focused & ready to go! That also means, set a schedule & take some time off electronics before bed!
- ★ Write down your parents/guardian's phone # in a safe place in case you don't know it and need to make a call after school. Come by the main office or counseling office after-school if you need to use the phone!
- ★ Decide on a location to meet your caregiver after school, especially if you are getting picked up. It can get busy out there!
- ★ Bring extra layers because the Outer Sunset gets chilly! :)
