Dear Families: A.P. Giannini is holding elections for school committees to be completed by **September 11, 2024**. We invite you to nominate yourself or others for the following:

- School Site Council (SSC) <u>click here</u>
- English Learners Advisory Committee (ELAC) <u>click here</u>

A <u>School Site Council (SSC)</u> must be established at **all** San Francisco Unified School District public schools. The elected members represent parents, students, community members, and school staff in school governance. The SSC is responsible for the development of the Academic Plan, and overall school site budget including any categorical funds. The SSC is expected to:

- •Review the SFUSD Strategic Plan: Beyond the Talk.
- •Review and analyze student data.
- ·Solicit community input and develop a needs assessment.
- •Assist the principal in developing the BSC/SPSA and school site budget.
- •Monitor the implementation and effectiveness of the BSC/SPSA on an ongoing basis.
- •Approve the Academic Plan and school site budget before it is submitted to the District for final review and approval.

The purpose of the **English Learners Advisory Committee (ELAC)** is to advise the principal, SSC and school staff on programs and services for *English Learners*. The tasks are similar to the SSC's (stated above) and also include: the annual language census and ways to make parents aware of the importance of regular school attendance.

The school council and committees are needed to support all school programs. You are invited to become a candidate for membership on the council and/or any or all of the committees of your choice. The school & district are responsible for providing you with the information and training you need to be an effective member. Generally, the groups meet once a month for two hours. Each member is elected for either a one or two year term. Family members often offer insights on how effective our school is in creating a positive learning environment and how well their children understand their assignments. Perspectives, and parent participation/involvement are important to our school. 

2024-25 School Year FREE School meals for all SFUSD students

We are thrilled to share that Governor Newsom has signed AB 107, which secures \$1.85 billion in the 2024–2025 CA Budget to continue School Meals For All! This applies to SFUSD students.

This means that all APG Students will have access to 1 free Breakfast and Lunch every school day! Supper is also available for students in our Beacon afterschool; this is free through CACFP funding.

Students, parents, and staff can find the school menu at sfusd.edu/menus.

SFUSD and CA Dept. of Education Policy: No student is denied a meal, a fruit and or vegetable required with every meal. Students will be offered nutritious meals to support their learning and development. We appreciate your partnership in talking to our new and transferring students who are yet to understand how the meal program works. Please talk with your student about how nutritious the school meals are and to encourage them eat at meal time!

NEW Meal Pin Numbers for Students at Middle Schools

The purpose of meal pin implementation is to ensure SNS is able to adhere to meal compliance and meal counting to reliably be reimbursed for complete student meals. This system **requests students to check out with a meal PIN after selecting their meal.** This allows us to continue serving free meals for students from multiple lines on campus, which helps keep the flow during meal service. Please share this information with any staff supporting meal service.

- To allow SNS Staff to support across the district, meal pin usage launch will be split up. Some sites will begin Pin number usage on Week 2 and some will launch on Week 3. You will receive an email detailing which week your school will start.
- Meal PINs are considered confidential student information, so they should not be shared with peers or teachers.

How will Students know their meal PIN?

- Students with an email on file received an email before school started from "SFUSD Student Nutrition Services" containing their individual Meal PIN and instructions on how to access their meal PIN digitally.
 - Meal PINs are also accessible for students in the StudentVue app.
- View here various ways a School Staff member can help a Student access their meal PIN.
 - Meal PINs are listed in Synergy.
 - As a last cause, Dining Staff can look up a student on their computer by name or Student ID. However, if this is done during meal service, it significantly delays the line.
