Our Arts Educators will share updates for the FALL 2025 art classes/departments about a month after school begins. We're thrilled that APG offers our students the largest variety of art courses for middle schoolers across the district.

APG SCHOOL

★ STUDENT SAFETY AND LOADING ZONES ★ Quick reminder that APG opens at 9am to all students; there is no early supervision or access to school for students prior to 9am and classes begin at 9:30am. Only those APG students who're enrolled in the Before-School, Spanish, and Mandarin programs may enter the school earlier for their 8:10am early care/ language classes.

Student Safety is a priority at APG! Most of our students walk, bike, skateboard, scooter, or take the school and MUNI buses to and from APG. In the first seven days of school, there have already been near-misses of hitting students in crosswalks, close calls of accidents with electric bikes/scooters/cars/buses, many parents/caregivers parked illegally in the staff-only parking lots, blocked neighbors' driveways, and other unsafe behavior during morning drop-offs and afternoon pick-ups. Please pay attention to all the students crossing the streets by our school. If your student is being driven to school, cars/motorcycles/all vehicles are NOT ALLOWED to pull into any of the white zones along the school parking lots on Ortega Street, 37th to 41st avenues, between 9:00am - 4:15pm. The MUNI and district School Buses also use a large part of 37th Avenue near Ortega as a drop off/pick up zone - please do not block them or cause traffic backups near the Ortega St & 37th Avenue intersection. Please do not park or pull over inside our two school parking lots, they are for staff use only from 8:30am - 5:30pm. Do not block neighbors driveways across Ortega street by school or on any other streets when dropping off or waiting for your students. Take note that Sunset Elementary School also has drop off at 9:30am every morning and dismissal times close to ours, so there are always younger students walking and crossing the streets on Ortega and 41st to 43rd Avenues. There are four crossing guards from Sunset Blvd down to 41st Avenue to help out with crosswalks - please listen to them when they hold up their Stop Signs. Let's work together to keep all our students safe! Thank you for making a better effort to read the 37th Avenue and Ortega Street signs, stay away from bus zones, avoid double parking, stop for students, and pull over for drop-off or pick-up in the correct zones or side streets.
