Subject: Proposed Staff and Funding Cuts at AP Giannini Middle School

Message:

Dear Superintendent Dr. Maria Su, SFUSD Cabinet Members, and BOE Commissioners,

I am reaching out as a concerned member in the A.P. Giannini Middle School (APG) community in regards to the proposed SFUSD budget cuts that would potentially eliminate several staff positions and funds at my student's wonderful public middle school.

I understand that district-wide fiscal responsibility is critical, given all that is happening with the CA Dept of Education overseeing the continued SFUSD budget deficit. Cutting our wellness staff, counselors, and security staff positions would have a severely negative impact on our 1,200 students and 130+ staff members at the largest public middle school community in San Francisco. These staff roles are not just beneficial—they are vital to the daily functioning of our school. These staff members are part of the glue that holds our APG school community together; they ensure that our classroom teachers can focus on teaching all our students, and support our administration so they have more time for instructional leadership. In light of recent tragedy and safety incidents that our APG community has suffered in the past two months, we need our wellness, security, and counseling team to remain robust and intact more than ever before. Our Wellness Center has been working very hard to meet the growing needs of all of our APG students. They have had over 1,800 visits in just 3.5 months! Our Social Worker and CHOW support the SEL, health, and overall well-being of over one thousand students, as well as communicate with families about issues their students are experiencing. Our security has helped students remain in a safe learning environment. Our counselors continue to work very hard to support 400 students and families, each! Our 8th grade counselor has the extra work to help 8th graders with high school applications and guidance; he encourages his 400 students to enroll in SFUSD high schools, helping your district enrollment numbers stay stable while students/families are strongly considering other options due to your budget cuts.

Our Wellness Staff, Security staff and Counselors help make sure our students are focused on learning in the classroom with their peers and teachers, instead of being out of class or school or increasing the learning loss gaps we've seen in recent years, all while keeping them safe onsite. We've had a few incidents and a tragedy affect our community this Fall, with even more need for our security, counselors and wellness team to remain strong and intact! As the largest public middle school in SFUSD with 1,200 students, cutting these essential staff positions at APG would be devastating for our students, as well as cause a huge decline in the support that our entire school community has relied on each school day.

I strongly urge you to reconsider your proposed cuts to our APG Wellness Staff, Security staff and Counselors positions, and request for you to please explore every alternative solution available to you that will not come at the expense of our 1,200 students' health, safety, well-being, and academic success. CA state funding pushed to support all middle school wellness centers in the past two years post pandemic and school lockdown, so I'm surprised to hear you want to cut wellness staff. APG is highly requested by 5th graders as their top choice and it is the largest public middle school in SF, with a substantially high population of Free-and-Reduced Lunch, Special Education, and CTIP qualifying students and families. The APG school community has already been overwhelmed and exhausted by stretching out the fewer resources the school receives and lack of Title 1 funding from the district, year after year. Our community keeps getting asked to do more with less fiscal support, and everyone is beyond the breaking point. The APG PTSA Fundraising goals have increased in the past two years to help with basic staff needs like supplies and boost morale with various staff appreciation events, but does not use, nor should they use, those funds to make up for the SFUSD Budget cut gaps to pay any of our essential staff. Your proposed cuts will not only impact our APG community, but also the district as APG students move up to high school and are unable to meet the goals and guardrails set by you, our SFUSD and BOE leaders.

Thank you for making time to read my letter and consider scaling back your proposed staffing cuts to APG. I appreciate all you do for our SF public school students and applaud your dedication to help our public schools thrive, as well as keep families and staff in our wonderful city!




